Symptom/Vehicle Issue: Hill Descent Control Inoperative, No LED Function On Switch After Sales Code Was Added

Customer Complaint/Technician Observation: Owner/operator and technician may find the Hill Descent Control (sales code BNH) does not function. The indicator LED does not illuminate. Condition occurs after Mopar Accessory installation, or a sales code was added.

Discussion: Perform a Restore Vehicle Configuration first prior to performing any further diagnostics. Following the Restore Vehicle Configuration routine successfully running, test drive the vehicle to confirm operation. Refer to owner's manual "Hill Descent Control (HDC) — If equipped" for operational information.

Rather, it captures all previous cases known that appear to be similar or related to the vehicle symptom / condition.
