This complete routine uses the VIN and ECU Variant to update the proper vehicle configuration and security information as built.

There are changes to the wiTECH procedure for Immobilizer Programming on this new vehicle architecture. This function provides the list of steps to take when replacing the BCM on this vehicle.

- 1. With original BCM still installed, generate Vehicle Scan Report
- 2. Obtain Authorization PIN which can be accessed by certain dealer personnel from the DealerCONNECT **Key Code** menu
- 3. Disconnect the main 12V battery
- 4. Remove the original BCM
- 5. Install the new BCM

6. Reconnect the battery and connect a **battery charger** to the vehicle to maintain adequate system voltage

7. Reconnect wiTECH

8. Run Guided Diagnostic Restore Vehicle Configuration

9. Run Guided Diagnostic **Immobilizer Modules Replacement** You will need the PIN obtained in step 2 10. Verify the vehicle starts and runs

11. Run the BCM MISC Function **Check BCM VIN** to make sure that the BCM has properly learned the VIN

12. Clear DTCs

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
