Infotainment system delays or slowness

Navigation system malfunctions.

Voice recognition malfunctions.

## **Service**

### **Software Update Procedure**

- 1. Connect a MTRMSP0702 battery maintainer/charger to the vehicle's 12 volt battery.
- 2. Switch the ignition to the ON position.
- 3. Switch ON the Infotainment System.
- 4. Check the software version by pressing and holding the square home key on the touchscreen menu to enter Service Mode.



- 5. Once in Service mode, press "Software update/versions" from the touchscreen menu.
- 6. Press "Start update" from the touchscreen menu.
- 7. Press "Version information" from the touchscreen menu.

If the current software level is lower than **1896**, proceed with this Technical Bulletin.

If the current software level is greater than or equal to **1896**, this work procedure does not apply.



#### **Create the USB Driver with SD/USB Creator:**

Refer to Technical Bulletin 2054866 (00-19-04) Set up SD/USB Creator to Obtain Software Updates. Use SD/USB Part Number **3G0.919.360.QK**.

## **Update Programming:**

#### Section 1: USB

- 1. Insert the USB Drive 3G0.919.360.QK into port 1 of the USB-C connection in the front center console.
- 2. Press and hold the square home key on the touch screen menu to enter Service Mode.
- 3. Press "Software update/versions" from the touchscreen menu.
- 4. Press "Start update" from the touchscreen menu.
- 5. Press "Update" from the touchscreen menu.
- 6. Press "USB 1" from the touchscreen menu.
- 7. Press "Next List Button" from the touchscreen menu.
- 8. Press "Start update" from the touchscreen menu.
- 9. The software update will now begin.



Please note that various screens may be displayed during the update process and the Infotainment display may switch off/on. This is normal behavior.

10. When the "Installation complete" window appears, press "OK" on the touchscreen menu.

#### Section 2: Software Version Management (SVM)

- 1. Connect the ODIS tester to the vehicle's Data Link Connector (DLC).
- 2. Initiate Guided Fault Findings (GFF) and allow the tester to complete interrogation of all modules.
- 3. Once GFF module interrogation is complete, click on the "Special Functions" tab.
- 4. Under "5F Information electronics 1 J794", select "Adapting Software".
- 5. Select option 1 "Software update via measure code".
- 6. Enter SVM code 3700.
- 7. Continue through the test plan, confirming steps as needed.



When the test is complete, the test result will read "Data version in the vehicle is current".

8. Once the update is complete, exit GFF and remove the USB from the USB drive.
