Dear Forest River Customer:

Forest River is alerting you to a DTNA Recall 22V554 involving certain 2023 Berkshire and Coachmen Sportscoach Class A Motorhomes. Please see the information below, which describes the issue and provides you with details on the steps you should take to have your vehicle repaired.

WHAT IS THE ISSUE?

Your engine is equipped with an Engine Control Module (ECM) that may have a manufacturing defect that could result in an engine stall without warning. An unexpected engine stall without the ability to restart the engine may lead to an increased risk of a crash.

Recall Notification Cummins Vitesco ECU Quality Spill (Companion Campaign)

Cummins has begun notifying its customers and repair locations of a safety related defect that exists in certain chassis manufactured by Freightliner Custom Chassis Corporation which have been delivered to your company.

A remedy without charge is now available, and owners may take their vehicle to a Cummins Distributor or authorized Warranty Dealer to have the recall performed. The Important Campaign Information (ICI) letter which includes a copy of the Cummins owner letter, along with a French translation, is attached to the email you have received. A list of potentially affected vehicles delivered to your company is also attached.

Your company may have an obligation to notify its dealers, distributors, and customers of this recall under Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations Part 577.13 and/or Motor Vehicle Safety Act Section 10(1).
