This document modifies the Volkswagen Warranty Policies and Procedures Manual.

Fuel Tank Suction Jet Pump Limited Warranty Extension

Volkswagen has extended the Warranty coverage for the Fuel Tank Suction Jet Pump to 15 years or 150,000 miles, whichever occurs first, from the vehicle's original in-service date for certain Volkswagen vehicles.

The vehicle's original in-service date is defined as the date the vehicle was delivered to either the original purchaser or the original lessee; or if the vehicle was first placed in service as a "demonstrator" or "company" car, on the date such vehicle was first placed in service.

Fuel Tank Suction Jet Pump Limited Warranty Extension is applicable for certain Volkswagen vehicles:

- ▶ 2015-2020 Golf
- ▶ 2015-2020 Golf SportWagen
- ▶ 2019-2020 Jetta A7 GLI

What is Covered

During the time/mileage period specified above, an authorized Volkswagen Dealer will diagnose and replace the Fuel Tank Suction Jet Pump at no cost to the customer if diagnosis confirms that the Fuel Tank Suction Jet Pump has failed from a warranty defect.

If diagnosis reveals that the vehicle has an unrelated issue(s), diagnosis and any necessary repairs to correct such issue(s) will not be covered under this warranty extension.

Transferability

This warranty extension is fully transferable to subsequent owners.

Additional information

This warranty extension does not cover damage or malfunctions caused by outside influence, such as an accident, or vehicle misuse or neglect, nor does it cover repairs that are necessary for proper diagnosis of these conditions or that are required to bring the vehicle up to factory specifications.

Vehicle Eligibility

To determine if a vehicle is eligible for the Fuel Tank Suction Jet Pump Limited Warranty Extension, check the VIN in Elsa > Vehicle Data. If the warranty extension is applicable to the vehicle, the "Enhanced Coverage" section of the "Vehicle Data" screen in Elsa will be populated with the warranty extension parameters.
