Case description

On certain MRU, GU, CTP, CV, RD, DM and DMM model chassis, rust may be seen around the end caps of the grille bars. If this condition is encountered, replacement grille bars are now available through the MACK Parts System. The replacement grille bars are made from a corrosion resistant metal to prevent rust from forming around the end caps. Refer to MACK net Parts to determine the proper replacement grille bar part numbers for the chassis being serviced.

Note: Does not apply to Mack Trucks Australia.

Note: Hardware for attaching the grille bars to the frame assembly is included with the replacement grille bars.

Repair

To replace the grille bars, simply remove the grille assembly from the vehicle and then use a drill to remove the retaining rivets securing the grille bars to the frame. Use the attachment hardware included with the replacement grille bars to secure the bars to the frame.
