SERVICE INFORMATION

If no TCM-related DTCs are stored and a customer has dissatisfaction with shifting during deceleration/re-acceleration, when coming to a stop, or during acceleration from a complete stop:

- Check Service COMM or Dealer Business Systems (DBS) National Service History to confirm if campaign R22B1 or R22A9 has been applied.

1. Has campaign R22B1 or R22A9 already been completed?

NO: Complete the related campaign bulletin.

YES: Proceed to step 2.

2. If the customer is still experiencing dissatisfaction as described above, and there are no TCM-related DTCs stored, refer to the ESM for further diagnostic information not covered by this bulletin.
