Symptom/Vehicle Issue: Check Engine Light Is On, No Start. DTC's P00FD, P0562,

P26F3

Discussion: If the check engine light is on and the vehicle exhibits a no start condition.

The concern could be caused by a loose cable attached to the Power Control Relay(PCR).

Diagnosis: Scan the vehicle for DTC's. If P00FD, P0562, and/or P26F3 are found. Inspect the power cables at the PCR.

Repair Procedure: If the cables are loose at the PCR, tighten them using service specifications.
