Technical Service Bulletin, TSB #22-01

Subject: Truma Combi Eco Plus pressure relief/drain valve

Dear Valued Dealer:

1. This TSB applies to all Ember units installed with a Truma Combi Eco Plus (Truma Combi).
2. Per manufacturer instructions, Ember ships all units to the dealer with the Truma Combi pressure relief/drain valve open.
 - This valve must be closed prior to operating the Truma Combi.
 - Failure to do this will result in water draining immediately beneath the front of the coach.

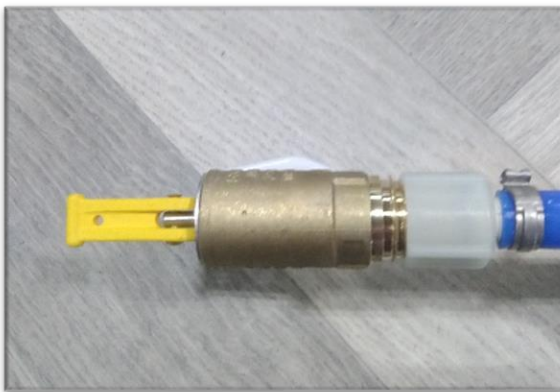


Figure 1: Truma Pressure Relief Valve

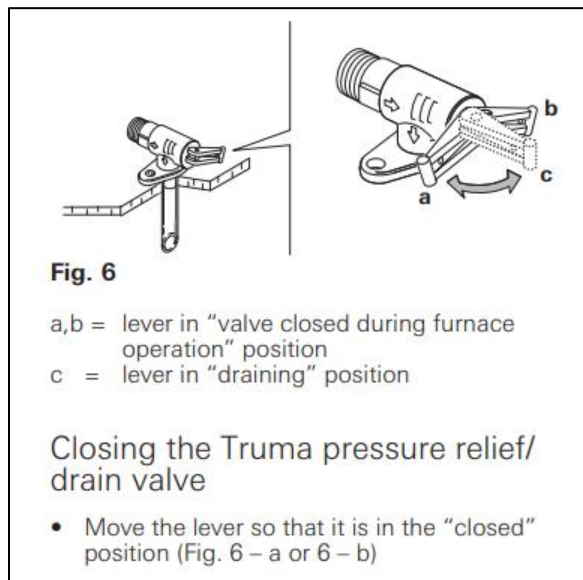
3. Location of the pressure release/drain valve:

17' and 19' Overland Series - configuration 1	In the partitioned area beneath the front bed or murphy couch. Remove the wooden panel to access.
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17', 19', and Tandem Axle Overland Series - configuration 2	In the storage area beneath the front bed or murphy couch. Accessible through a cut out in the bulkhead panel.
Tandem Axle Overland Series	In the partitioned area beneath the front bed or murphy couch. Remove the wooden panel to access.
ROK/ROL	In the partitioned area beneath the futon sofa

- Please review the manufacturer's operating manual for important safety information before proceeding.
- This valve is to be placed in the closed position prior to operation of the unit's water system.
