| <b>Condition</b>                  | Some customers may comment that when starting the engine from the RUN power mode, the engine will idle at low RPMs (400 RPMs) and there will be no throttle response.  |
| <b>Cause</b>                      | This condition may be caused by the wrong generator installed.   |
| <b>Information</b>                | <p>Check IVH to verify if the generator has been replaced:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Generator part number 13539731 is released for 2022 LM2 with J21 engineering model year</li> <li>– Generator part number 13540929 is released for 2022 LM2 with J22 engineering model year</li> </ul> <p>If it was found that the J1 vehicle had the incorrect J2 generator installed, replace the generator with the part number indicated above, per engineering model year.</p> |
