	<u>New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory:</u> It is a violation of federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety. <u>Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory:</u> Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.

The New York State Department of Motor Vehicles (NYS DMV) is alerting you about a dangerous, recalled airbag in the following vehicle:

According to records from Audi, the vehicle listed above has a dangerous, recalled airbag. If the airbag deploys, a part inside may explode and spray sharp metal fragments that could <u>seriously injure or even</u> <u>kill</u> you or someone in your vehicle.

Audi is one of 19 vehicle manufacturers affected by this urgent airbag safety recall. The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) reports 19 confirmed deaths from other manufacturers in the United States and hundreds of alleged injuries resulting from this defect.

Your safety on New York State roadways is our top priority!

If you believe that Audi or your Audi dealership is unable to remedy the defect for free within a reasonable time, you may submit a complaint to the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Avenue S.E., Washington, DC 20590, or you may call the toll-free Vehicle Safety Hot Line at 1–888-327-4236 (TTY: 1-800-424-9153), or go to NHTSA.gov. This notice is being provided and paid for by Audi, in cooperation with the NYS DMV. Taxpayer dollars were not used. Due to the serious nature of this recall, the NYS DMV is providing limited assistance with these notices to individuals who may be impacted by this recall. The manufacturer is fully responsible for this recall, notification of the recall, and any repairs. This notification does not create a duty upon the NYS DMV to provide notice nor any repair requirement regarding this recall, or any other recalls or safety-related information. Further communication regarding this notice, including scheduling repairs or verifying recall information, must be directed to Audi and not to the NYS DMV.
