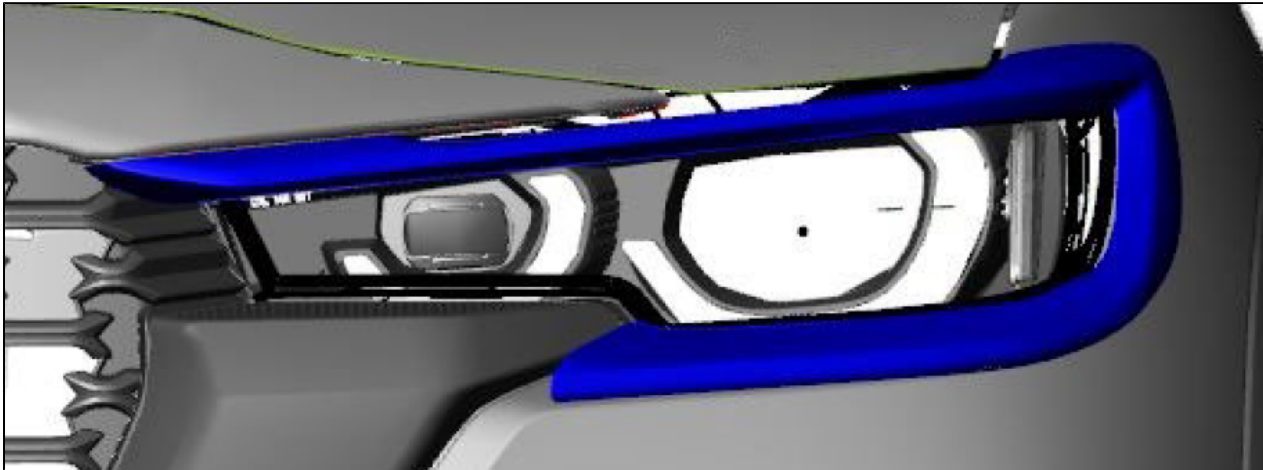

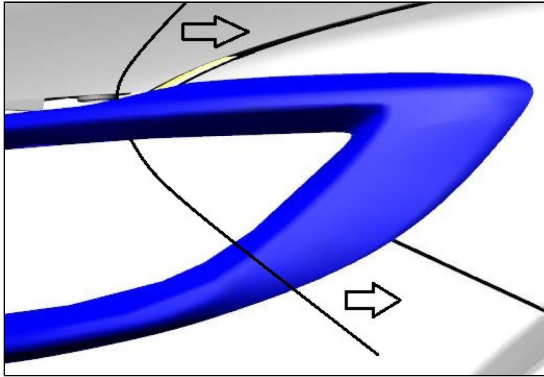

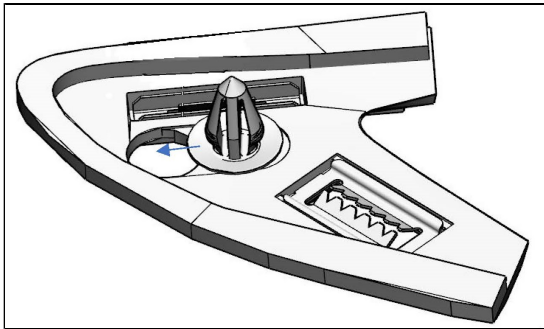

## REPAIR PROCEDURE

## Front Facia Removal

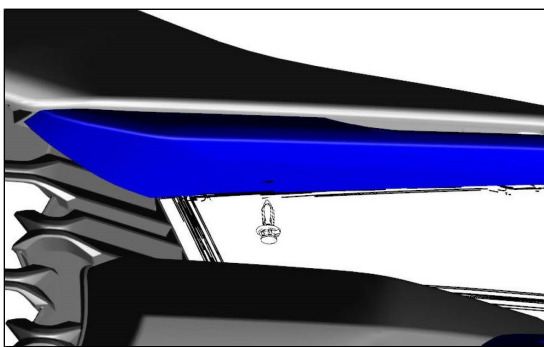


1. Using heavy-duty fishing line cut tape around the corner of garnish mounted to fender.
2. In a sawing motion pull the fishing line rearward and around the perimeter of the garnish to cut the tape.
3. With the hood open, run the fishing line between garnish and headlamp.  
**NOTE: Do not try to pull garnish away from the fender.**



4. The upper and lower portion of the garnish will remain attached to the fascia.
5. Pull fascia forward off vehicle releasing fender clips from side brackets.
6. Clips can then be removed from the fenders.

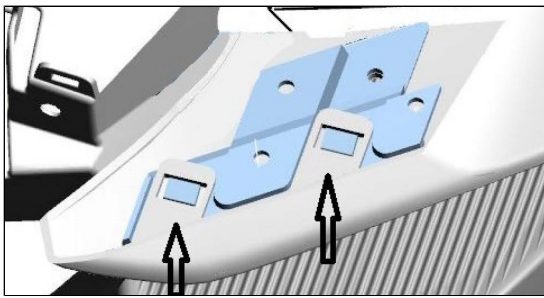
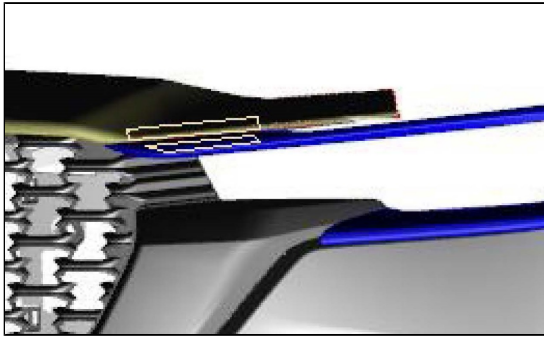
## Upper Front Facia Removal



1. Remove the clip holding garnish to the upper bracket

## Upper Front Facia Removal



2. Apply masking tape to the upper grille and garnish.

3. Using a small flat tip screwdriver press down the upper bracket locking tabs and gently lift the garnish tabs and pull the garnish from the bracket.
