Condition	Some customers may comment that the radio will not turn off after the vehicle's ignition has been turned off and the driver's door has been opened. (Retained Accessory Power will not cancel.) If the vehicle is left in this state for an extended amount of time, this may also result in a discharged or dead battery.
Concern	This concern may be caused by a software anomaly. A failed Over-The-Air update for the Serial Data Gateway Module (SDGM) may cause this concern.

Correction:

1. Check to see if the vehicle has recently received OTA Field Action N222379480 by checking the infotainment system under Settings, then Updates.

Note: A failed OTA may not show in infotainment history.

- 2. Perform the Battery Inspect/Test procedure in Service Information.
- 3. After recovering the Battery Inspect/Test procedure, perform the Battery Electrical Drain/Parasitic Load Test procedure in Service Information to confirm there is no parasitic drain.
- 4. Using SPS2, check the Serial Data Gateway Module (SDGM) for the latest software. Program the SDGM if an update is needed.
