

**Symptom/Vehicle Issue:** Battery Warning Lamp On, Battery Charging Voltage Fluctuates

Owner Complaint/Technician Observation: Owner complains that the battery warning lamp turns on, and battery charging fluctuates lower and higher than expected. Technician observed Diagnostic Trouble Codes (DTCs) P065A-Generator System Performance, P2504-00 Charging System Output High, P2503-00 Charging System Output Low.

**Discussion:** If one of the above DTCs are present inspect the A801 circuit connections at the High Current Fuse Array (HCFA) and the alternator/generator B+. Secure alternator connection D3000A nut at the back of the alternator as needed to 14NM (10ft lbs).
