Repair Procedure: Inspect the harness routing at the rear seat panel driver side, ensure no harness pinching at harness retaining clip position as shown, pg's 1-4.

- 1. Unhook toe kick straps from underneath seat
- 2. Remove screws circled below










3. Remove panel from button like shown below

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








Examine harness routing at clip area, repair and reposition harness as needed if pinched at this location; see proper harness routing pg 4.

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












- 4. Reroute harness as seen above
