Customer Complaint/Technician Observation: Remote inoperative or unable to pair to RSE.

Discussion: Ensure the batteries are good and installed properly in remote and FireTVs are on. When attempting to pair a remote, if the light on the remote blinks orange instead of blue, the remote is paired to another device. To unpair the remote, go to the other device and in the same menu as above, click on the remote and select "Unpair".

To Pair a Remote:

1. To access the side bar menu, touch the screen. Select Settings.



2. Select Bluetooth.



3. Select Voice Remotes with Alexa.

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

4. Select Add New Remote.



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
