

Symptom/Vehicle Issue: Service Electric Power Steering (EPS) Message Displayed on Cluster Upon Start Up

Customer Complaint/Technician Observation: Owner complains of a cluster message to service the EPS system shortly after starting the vehicle. Technician observed the Diagnostic Trouble Codes (DTCs) C2217-00 EPS Module Internal, and C1592-00 EPS Motor Circuit were set at the same time, within the same ignition cycle.

Discussion: When the above DTCs are setting as described above, it is best to check the battery charge level (charge as needed) and then check the EPS redundant B+ feeds and grounds (G905a G906A) for any voltage drop prior to any further repairs, Fig 1 and 2.















