SUBJECT:

RamBox Applique Separation/Delamination

OVERVIEW:

This bulletin involves inspecting and possibly replacing both RamBox lids and appliques with updated parts.

MODELS:

2019 - **2022**	(DS)	RAM 1500 Pickup
2019 - **2022**	(DJ)	RAM 2500 Pickup
2019 - **2022**	(D2)	RAM 3500 Pickup

- NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles within the following markets/countries: North America.
- NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles built on or before **March 31, 2021 (MDH 0331XX)** equipped with a RamBox Cargo Management System (Sales Code XB9) and a 6'4" Cargo Box.

SYMPTOM/CONDITION:

Customers may comment on the following:

• One or both of the RamBox appliques are separating/delaminating (Fig. 2) from the RamBox lids.

DIAGNOSIS:

If the customer describes the symptom/condition listed above, perform the Repair Procedure.

REPAIR PROCEDURE:

NOTE: If no separation/delamination is found, do not replace the appliques and lids.

Appliques and box lids must be replaced as a pair. If one has separation/delamination issues, both must be replaced.

- **Remove and discard the RamBox lid with applique. Refer to the detailed service procedures available in DealerCONNECT/Service Library under: Service Info>23 - Body / Exterior / Box, Pickup / Removal.
- 2. Feather sand the surface area of the new primed applique with P500 sandpaper.
- 3. Which type of basecoat will be used?
 - Solvent Basecoat >>> Proceed to Step 1 of the Solvent Basecoat Procedure.
 - Waterborne Basecoat >>> Proceed to Step 1 of the Waterborne Basecoat Procedure.

Solvent Basecoat Procedure:

- 1. Refer to the approved refinish paint suppliers (Akzo Nobel, Axalta, BASF, PPG, Sherwin Williams and Valspar) recommended process for cleaning the primed plastic surface area.
- 2. Clean the paint surface area per the paint suppliers recommendations.
- 3. Apply DAS302X sealer or equivalent.
- 4. Apply DBC basecoat with DX57 hardener or equivalent.
- 5. Apply DC4000 clearcoat with SL814 universal flexibilizer or equivalent.
- Install the new RamBox lid. Refer to the detailed service procedures available in DealerCONNECT/Service Library under: Service Info>23 - Body / Exterior / Box, Pickup / Installation.
- Install the new applique to the RamBox lid. Refer to the detailed service procedures available in DealerCONNECT/Service Library under: Service Info>23 - Body / Exterior / Box, Pickup / Installation.

Waterborne Basecoat Procedure:

- 1. Refer to the approved refinish paint suppliers (Akzo Nobel, Axalta, BASF, PPG, Sherwin Williams and Valspar) recommended process for cleaning the primer plastic surface area.
- 2. Clean the paint surface area per the paint suppliers recommendations.
- 3. Apply ECS2X sealer with SL814 universal flexibilizer or equivalent.
- 4. Apply EHP basecoat with T492 and T581 hardener or equivalent.
- 5. Apply DC4000 clearcoat with SL814 universal flexibilizer or equivalent.
- Install the new RamBox lid. Refer to the detailed service procedures available in DealerCONNECT/Service Library under: Service Info>23 - Body / Exterior / Box, Pickup / Installation.
- Install the new applique to the RamBox lid. Refer to the detailed service procedures available in DealerCONNECT/Service Library under: Service Info>23 - Body / Exterior / Box, Pickup / Installation.
