

Cause	The cause of the condition may be interference contact between the applique and the painted surface.

Correction	and refinish liftgate as necessary.	

#### **Service Procedure**




 Remove the rear closure center applique assembly (2). Refer to *Rear Closure Center Applique Replacement* in the Service Manual.

**Note:** Refer to the latest revision of the GM Approved Refinish Materials book to identify the paint systems you may use that have been engineered to meet GM standards.
