## **PURPOSE**

This bulletin provides instructions on how to remedy noise heard from the HVAC system (heater, air conditioner, ventilation vents) when the blower motor is turned on.

## BACKGROUND

Customers may advise of noises heard from the HVAC system when the blower motor is turned on. This noise may be caused by the dimensional size variations between the air filter and HVAC casing which may permit gaps. These gaps could allow leaves to become lodged and/or when the cabin air filter is removed, leaves may fall and become trapped in the blower motor area, resulting in noise.



## WORK PROCEDURE

On a customer complaint basis, perform the steps below and refer to the following section of the Service manual as necessary: Group 55 - Heater, Air Conditioning and Ventilation, Heater Unit and Blower Assembly - Disassembly and Assembly.

1. Remove the blower motor and remove the leaves that linger around the HVAC case and blower motor fan.

# WORK PROCEDURE (Continued)

- 2. Replace the cabin air filter with a new one (part #7803A109).
- 3. Install the blower motor and check for noise.
  - If the noise is still present, leaves may have attached to the evaporator: a. Remove the HVAC ASSY.
    - b. Remove the leave from inside of evaporator and HVAC case.
