THE VEHICLE ALARM SOUNDS WHEN UNLOCKING AND/OR OPENING THE DOORS WITH THE INTELLIGENT KEY

APPLIED VEHICLES: 2022 Pathfinder (R53)

APPLIED DATES: Built before October 18, 2021

IF YOU CONFIRM

The customer states that the vehicle security system (alarm) may inadvertently sound when unlocking and/or opening any of the vehicle's doors with the Intelligent Key.

ACTION

1. Confirm the current BCM hardware part number.

HINT: This number is the hardware number on the outside of the BCM, and can also be found with C-III plus.

2. If the current hardware part number is 284B1-6TA0E, replace the BCM with the part listed in the **PARTS INFORMATION**.

HINT: If the current part number <u>is not</u> 284B1-6TA0E, this bulletin does not apply. Please refer to the ESM for further diagnostic information.

- Refer to the ESM: ELECTRICAL & POWER CONTROL > BODY CONTROL SYSTEM > REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION > BCM (BODY CONTROL MODULE) > Removal and Installation
- After replacing the BCM, perform ADDITIONAL SERVICE WHEN REPLACING BCM.

 SYSTEM > BASIC INSPECTION > ADDITIONAL SERVICE WHEN
 REPLACING BCM > Work Procedure
