Condition	Some customers may comment on a rattle or flutter noise heard under the vehicle at highway speeds.	
Cause	The cause of the condition may be the lower panel on FRONT WHEEL DRIVE vehicles only may be making contact with the subframe assembly.	
Correction	Remove both panels and add 5 mm of adhesive foam tape to area.	

## Service Procedure

If you encounter a vehicle with the above concern, complete the following:

1. Raise and support the vehicle. Refer to *Lifting and Jacking the Vehicle*.

2. Remove both trim panels illustrated above.

3. Apply foam tape (Kent Automotive P/N 83327 or equivalent) to the areas illustrated above on both panels.

**Important:** Before applying any foam, clean and prep area to verify that there is no debris that would prevent the foam from sticking properly to the panel.

**Important:** Foam should be slightly taller than the pushpin to ensure compression

4. Reinstall panels and verify condition is corrected.
