Condition	Some customers may comment that after having a Short Range Radar (SRR) module replaced (part number: 84907387), now when they are driving past another vehicle the Size Blind Zone Alert (SBZA) indicator will not illuminate in the side mirrors but will illuminate when another vehicle is passing them.
	Note: This condition will only be present after a SRR module is replaced using part number 84907387.
Cause	An anomaly in the SRR module may be at fault causing the SBZA to perform poorly.

Correction:

To repair this condition, using the radio display go into Settings then System and perform a "Return to Factory Settings". This will reset the modules allowing the SBZA to operate properly.
