
Symptom/Vehicle Issue: Customer Indicates Heat Is Blowing Warm Not Hot.

Customer Complaint/Technician Observation: Inspect cabin air filter for being wet or damp.

Discussion: A Blocked cowl/plenum drain can lead to water intrusion into the cabin air filter. If it gets wet or freezes the airflow will be reduced and effect the consistency of heat into the cabin. Follow the process below to remove cowl blockages.

With Open Hood:

- 1. Remove both wipers from the unit, retain all parts and bolts
- Remove 8 pins from cowl top screen, retain all pins for re-insertion once work is completed




With Open Hood:

- 1. Remove foil-back butyl patch (take care unless back-up patch is available for re-application)
- 2. Inspect cowl side flapper baffle area for any obstructing objects
- 3. Reach into cavity and push flap open by reaching between slots shown on baffle to ensure it is not stuck or kept shut from objects on outside of unit in fender area



With Open Hood:

- 1. Inspect cowl side flapper baffle area for any obstructing objects
- 2. Reach into cavity and push flap open by reaching between slots shown on baffle to ensure it is not stuck or kept shut from objects on outside of unit in fender area




With Open Hood:

1. Re-install cowl screen and insert all 8 push-pins correctly




