SUBJECT:

6.7L Cummins No Start

OVERVIEW:

This bulletin involves replacing the starter nut with the more conductive nut.

MODELS:

2022	(DJ)	RAM 2500 Pickup
2022	(D2)	RAM 3500 Pickup
2022	(DD)	RAM 3500 Cab Chassis
2022	(DP)	RAM 4500/5500 Cab Chassis

NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles within the following markets/countries: North America, Enlarged Europe, India/Asia Pacific, Middle East/Africa and South America.

NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles built on or after April 14, 2021 (MDH0414XX) and on or before July 21, 2022 (MDH0721XX) equipped with a 6.7L I6 Cummins Turbo Diesel Engine (Sales Codes ETL, ETM and ETN).

SYMPTOM/CONDITION:

The customer may experience the following:

A long crank with no start, or a no crank, no start.

NOTE: This symptom/condition is caused from a poor connection to the starter.

PARTS REQUIRED:

1	06512544AA	Nut (Starter B+ Cable)

DIAGNOSIS:

If a customer's VIN is listed in VIP or your RSU VIN list, perform the Repair Procedure. (This RSU only applies to vehicles on the RSU VIN list).

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REPAIR PROCEDURE:

- 1. Disconnect and isolate both the negative and positive battery cable(s). Refer to the detailed service procedures available in DealerCONNECT/Service Library under: Service Info>08 Electrical / 8F Engine Systems / Battery System / Standard Procedure.
- 2. Raise and support vehicle. Refer to the detailed service procedures available in DealerCONNECT/Service Library under: Service Info>04 Vehicle Quick Reference / Hoisting / Standard Procedure.
- 3. Remove the B+ cable nut and the B+ cable from the starter stud (Fig. 1). Discard the nut.



- 2 Starter Stud
- 4. Using the new B+ cable nut, install the B+ cable on the starter stud (Fig. 1) . Tighten the B+ cable nut to 18 N·m (13 ft. lbs.).
- 5. Lower the vehicle.
- 6. Connect the positive and negative battery cable(s). Refer to the detailed service procedures available in DealerCONNECT/Service Library under: Service Info>08 Electrical / 8F Engine Systems / Battery System / Standard Procedure.
