

TBB is announcing a change to the Type A chassis number assignment process. Ford has announced reductions to planned production rates for chassis planned for TBB body up-fit. In order to minimize the impact to our production scheduling, the following changes to the current process are going into effect immediately.

- No chassis number(s) will be assigned against a chassis until Ford commits it to production and assigns a VIN.
- No chassis pricing can be provided until Ford assigns a VIN.
- For Dealers who had placed a chassis order, either through Olathe or the TBB Stock Program, a communication will be sent if a VIN is assigned to a chassis associated with a known TBB Dealer order.
- For Dealers who have already requested a chassis number, those chassis numbers are dependent upon VIN number assignment, as well. If those chassis do not get built, the chassis number tied to them will be void.

From a transparency perspective, without a VIN, the chassis does not exist. We understand this may create inconvenience(s) and it isn't where we want to be. However, it is necessary to make these changes sooner, rather than later, to manage the process. We will continue to monitor the Ford production plan and will announce any significant changes that would alter the direction of this announcement. However, we anticipate this being the new process for the foreseeable future.
