# Subject: Squeaking Noise, Vehicle Will Not Charge, Accessory Drive Belt Damaged, Crank/No Start, Battery Light On, Drive Belt Came Off, Noise Under Hood and/or Charge Lamp Illuminated on the Drivers Information Center (DIC)



Condition	<ul> <li>Some customers may comment on one or more of the following conditions:</li> <li>Squeaking noise</li> <li>Vehicle will not charge</li> <li>Accessory drive belt damaged</li> <li>Crank/No Start</li> <li>Battery light On</li> <li>Drive belt came off</li> <li>Noise under hood</li> <li>Charge Lamp illuminated on DIC</li> <li>Note: Check vehicle history to see if the belt has been previously replaced for the same concern.</li> <li>Some technicians may find during inspection the accessory drive belt is damaged or has come off.</li> </ul>
Cause	This condition may be caused by a mis-machined crankshaft damper where the 6 rib belt track was machined too far forward relative to the 10 rib Supercharger belt track, causing the 6 rib belt to run off the front of the pulleys.
Correction	To determine if the damper is suspect, measure the damper rib distance. Refer to Additional Information. If the measurement is narrower than 18mm, the damper and accessory drive belt will need to be replaced.

## **Additional Information**

**Note:** Before installing the NEW damper, ensure that the measurement is within specification.



Good parts should measure 18mm +/- 1mm across ribs as shown in the graphic above.
