Symptom/Vehicle Issue: Blind Spot Warning Message On Instrument Cluster. Mid Range Radar Wrong Mounting Diagnostic Trouble Code.

Discussion: Some recently replaced Mid Range Radar (MRR) Modules have been found to have wrong mounting Diagnostic Trouble Codes (DTCs) and no problem found when tested. The module installation must be checked if one of the below DTCs are set. Also refer to Fig 1 for an example of a MRR not fully installed in the bracket and a good example.

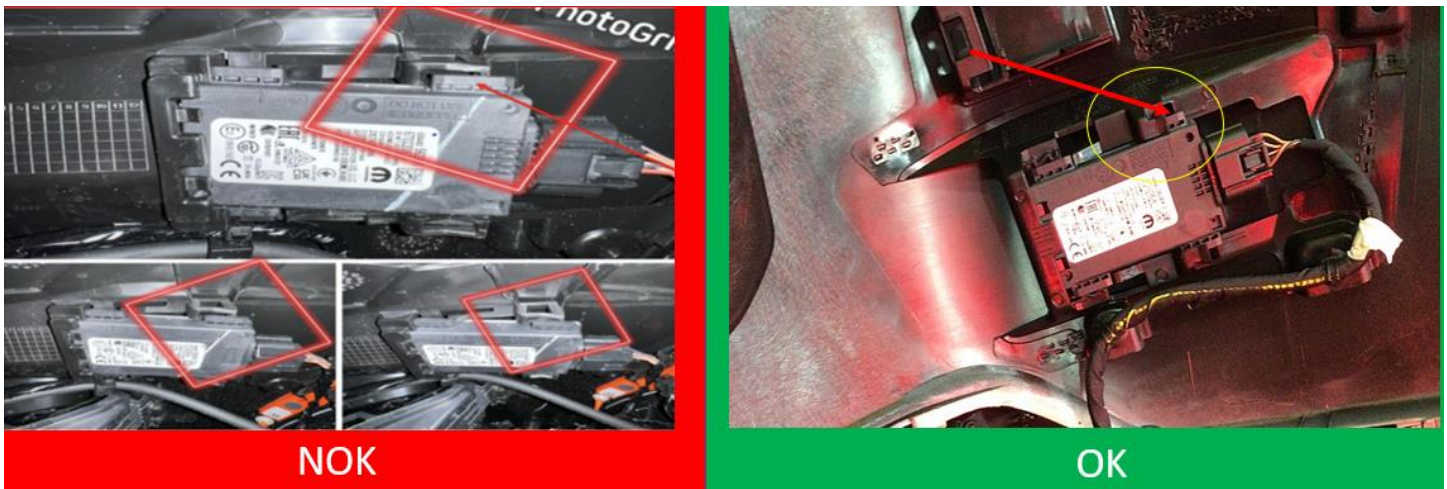
