

Introduction

Some 2020 – 2022 model year vehicles equipped with 17CY+ Panasonic Audio (versions less than 1226) and Navigation (versions less than 1225 or 1245 with 20 Teammate) may exhibit one or more of the following conditions:

- Navigation reset while entering a destination.
- Voice command does not recognize Starbucks.
- "Unable to establish audio connection" message, and Alexa is unable to resume after Android Auto™ interruption.
- Soft buttons grayed Out during panoramic view monitor transition.
- HVAC fan speed displayed incorrectly.
- Volume cannot be adjusted with the rear seat remote control.
- Multimedia system reboots when iPhone[®] is connected via USB.
- Energy flow information is missing on energy monitor screen.
- Clearance sonar indication on backup camera screen is missing.
- Audio from USB devices intermittently works.
- iPhone[®] ringer continues after answering call.
- Audio titles not displayed.
- Toyota apps screen menu not displayed.

Some 2020 – 2021 model year vehicles equipped with 17CY+ Panasonic Navigation (version less than 1150) and Audio (version less than 1163) may exhibit one or more of the following conditions:

- Poor map screen touch operation.
- Navigation system reset.
- Climate temperature control difficult to operate.
- "Waiting for the Beep" message displayed, voice recognition does not start when pressing the push to talk button.
- Blower motor speed incorrectly displayed.
- White CarPlay[®] screen when connecting iPhone12[®].
- Navigation sub-screen blank while playing a CD.
- Inoperative rear seat entertainment track controls.
- Abnormal energy flow screen appearance.
- Incorrect FM or SiriusXM[®] genre Information.



Introduction (continued)

Some 2020 – 2021 model year vehicles equipped with 17CY+ Panasonic Navigation (version less than 1110) and Audio (version less than 1123) may exhibit one or more of the following conditions:

- Android AutoTM music does not resume after the vehicle is turned OFF and then ON.
- Incorrect cover art is displayed from a previous song.
- CarPlay® unexpectedly resumes after turning audio OFF and pushing Menu switch.
- MAP switch inoperative when in a Bluetooth[®] call and connected to Android Auto[™].
- Pop noise when selecting track up/down of USB audio.
- Touch pad feedback continues when feedback setting is turned OFF.
- Blank navigation screen.
- Low Bluetooth[®] audio volume.
- Bluetooth[®] connection screen button is grayed out.
- Climate temperature control difficult to operate.
- Menu buttons do not light up when pushed.
- Blower level is not displayed correctly.

Some 2020 – 2021 model year Lexus vehicles equipped with Navigation (version less than 1060) and Audio (version less than 1060) may exhibit one or more of the following conditions:

- Display screen distortion/pixilation.
- iOS device does not connect until disconnecting and reconnecting USB cable.
- iOS device does not connect until the vehicle is turned OFF and then ON.

Some 2020 model year Lexus vehicles equipped with Navigation (version less than 1030) and Audio (version less than 1036) may exhibit one or more of the following conditions:

- Abnormal clock operation in Auto Daylight Savings Time mode.
- CarPlay[®] inoperative.
- USB audio does not resume after turning the engine OFF and ON.
- Reply button not displayed on the text message screen.
- Reset during phonebook transfer.
- Bluetooth[®] calls disconnected.
- Enform submenu inoperative from touch screen.
- Push to Talk button long press starts native voice recognition.
- Destination Assist frozen when pressing the SOS button.
- Navigation screen slow booting or does not boot up.



Introduction (continued)

Some 2020 model year Lexus vehicles equipped with Navigation (version less than 1006) and Audio (version less than 1007) may exhibit one or more of the following conditions:

- Voice Command "Barge-in" defaults to OFF.
- Handset Mode label incorrect.
- Android Auto[™] music does not resume after using Destination Assist.
- Abnormal return/back arrow illumination operation.
- Destination Assist will not cancel while playing Android Auto[™] music.
- Gracenote cover art is not displayed.
- Incorrect Destination Assist vehicle position.

A software update is now available to address these conditions. Follow the Software Update Procedure in this bulletin to address these conditions.


B. Wait for the display to switch to the Caution screen, then select Continue.
