## **DESCRIPTION**

Some customers may expierience any of the following:

- · Engine no start due to battery discharge
- · Ignition cannot be turned OFF
- · Infotainment remains ON after the ignition is turned OFF
- · Infotainment display is blank
- Commander switch is inoperative
- · Remote transmitters are inoperative

This may be caused by a liquid spill at the front cup holder.



- 3. Inspect the instrument panel harness connector C-16 for liquid spill corrosion.

- · No This service information does not apply. Continue with normal MGSS troubleshooting.
- 4. Repair/replace connector C-16 as needed.
- 5. Wrap connector C-16 with electrical tape to protect it from liquid spills.
- 6. Verify the repair.
