





Condition	Some customers may comment that the Mil is illuminated. Some technicians may see one or more of the following DTCs set in the ECM: • U1345: Engine Control Module LIN Bus 1 • U02A9: Loss of Communication with Charge Air Cooler Pump • U0284: Lost Communication with Active Grill Air Shutter Actuator 1 • U0285: Lost Communication with Active Grill Air Shutter Actuator 2 Additionally, other communication DTCs related to LIN modules might be set.	
Cause 1	DTC U02A9 and U1345 may be caused by an unsealed pump electrical connector allowing water leakage into the (M10) connector.	
Cause 2	<ul> <li>DTC U1345, U0284 and U0285 may be caused by the engine wiring harness to active grille air shutter actuator in-line connector:</li> <li>Not properly connected</li> <li>Not properly hold by the rear clip</li> <li>Grounded on the radiator</li> </ul>	
Cause 3	DTC U1345 and U0284 may be caused by the active grill air shutter wiring pinched at th radiator support.
