Some customers may comment that their camera view appears to be pointing downwards or have a zoomed in appearance.

Condition

Cause

When the customer travels long distances with a heavy object attached to trailering attachment point on vehicle (i.e Heavy Trailers, Boats, any vehicle accessories etc) will create this phenomenon.

Correction:

- 1. Verify the "Zoomed In Pointed Downward Rear-View Camera" condition is visible on display, please follow the next steps.
- 2. Confirm that there is no physical damage associated to rear camera/rear tailgate area.
- 3. Remove any trailers/accessories from vehicle.
- 4. Once vehicle is at a free-state without any trailering attachments, technician shall drive vehicle under 10 MPH in a straight line until VPM rear camera re-alignment.
- 5. VPM will re-align rear camera respectively. Perform 2 Key Cycles and place vehicle in reverse to confirm camera viewport is in nominal condition.
