


**Subject: Upper Glove Box Door does not Open when Button is Depressed or Takes Multiple Presses to Open**

<b>Involved Region or Country</b>	North America, Middle East, Israel
<b>Condition</b>	Some customers may comment that it takes multiple tries to open the upper glove box and/or the customer must hit the upper glove box door or push the button several times for the mechanism to engage.
<b>Cause</b>	<div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p style="text-align: right; font-size: small;">6361432</p> <p>The cause of the condition may be that the latch pawl is too long and not releasing the door, causing the door to remain closed.</p>
<b>Correction</b>	If the door will not open, you will need to file/sand down the latch pawl following the Service Procedure outlined below.

### Service Procedure

**Important:** Service agents must comply with all International, Federal, State, Provincial, and/or Local laws applicable to the activities it performs under this bulletin, including but not limited to handling, deploying, preparing, classifying, packaging, marking, labeling, and shipping dangerous goods. 1. Sand down the tip of the latch pawl (callout #1) about 0.2 mm.
2. Check the upper glove box after the latch pawl has been sanded to see if the glove box door works as intended. Otherwise, proceed with sanding off the surface a little more.
3. If the upper glove box works as intended, the work is complete.

**Important:** The glove box does not need to be removed for this procedure. The box is shown out of vehicle for illustration only.

### Parts Information

No parts are required for this repair.
