AUTOMATIC BACK DOOR DOES NOT OPEN

APPLIED VEHICLES: 2021-2023 Rogue (T33)

APPLIED DATES: VINs beginning with 5N1: Built on or before August 1, 2022

VINs beginning with JN8: Built on or before August 3, 2022

APPLIED GRADES: SV with Premium Package, SL, Platinum

IF YOU CONFIRM

The automatic back door will not open when using the Intelligent Key, back door request button, or the interior dash button,

OR

Any one or combination of the DTCs listed below are stored in AUTO BACK DOOR ECU.

- U2369-87 CAN Comm Circuit
- U2169-87 CAN Comm Circuit
- B2417-15 Touch Sensor Circuit LH Open
- B2416-15 Touch Sensor Circuit RH Open
- B2426-11 Spindle Sensor LH
- B2436-19 Spindle Motor LH
- B2437-19 Spindle Motor RH

ACTION

Replace the Automatic Back Door Control Unit.

IMPORTANT: The purpose of **ACTION** (above) is to give you a quick idea of the work you will be performing. You MUST closely follow the entire **SERVICE PROCEDURE** as it contains information that is essential to successfully completing this repair.

SERVICE PROCEDURE

IMPORTANT:

Before performing diagnostics on an **APPLIED VEHICLE** that appears to have an inoperative Automatic (Power) Back Door (e.g., the door will not open, close, latch, etc.):

- Confirm that the Power Back Door is set to "ON" in the Vehicle Settings menu of the Vehicle Information Display.
 - a. To access/change the Power Back Door setting, use the scroll dial and the Left/Right buttons on the steering wheel to navigate to the Vehicle Settings menu.
 - b. If Power Back Door is "OFF" toggle to "ON".

Erase Stored DTCs

- 1. Perform Erase All DTCs.
 - Did the "current" DTCs erase?

YES: Skip to step 2 on page 3.

NO: Unplug the Automatic Back Door Control Unit located behind the luggage side finisher, reconnect it to erase the DTCs, and then proceed to step 2 on page 3.

➤ To access and unplug the Automatic Back Door Control Unit, refer to the ESM: BODY EXTERIOR, DOORS, ROOF & VEHICLE SECURITY > DOOR & LOCK > REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION > AUTOMATIC BACK DOOR CONTROL UNIT

- 2. Replace the Automatic Back Door Control Unit.
 - Refer to the ESM: BODY EXTERIOR, DOORS, ROOF & VEHICLE SECURITY > DOOR & LOCK > REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION > AUTOMATIC BACK DOOR CONTROL UNIT > Removal and Installation
- 3. Perform ADDITIONAL SERVICE WHEN REPLACING AUTOMATIC BACK DOOR CONTROL UNIT.
 - Refer to the ESM: BODY EXTERIOR, DOORS, ROOF & VEHICLE SECURITY > DOOR & LOCK > BASIC INSPECTION > ADDITIONAL SERVICE WHEN REPLACING AUTOMATIC BACK DOOR CONTROL UNIT > Work Procedure
