# BULLETIN NOTES APPLICABLE MODEL(S)/VINS

2024 CX-90 (with electric tilt/telescopic steering) with VINS lower than JM3KK\*\*\*\*\*107178 (produced before March 24, 2023)

## DESCRIPTION

Some vehicles may exhibit an abnormal noise (creaking noise) when operating the electric steering tilt/telescopic function. This is caused by adhesion and slippage occur repeatedly between the steering column and the set screw due to over tightening of a set screw in the steering tilt/telescopic mechanism. To eliminate this concern, the tightening amount (torque) of the set screw has been changed.

Customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.

## **REPAIR PROCEDURE**

1. Verify the customer concern.

2. Loosen the set screw at the right side of the steering column tilt according to the following procedure.

a. Remove the Driver Side Lower Panel and Lower Column Cover according to the instructions on MGSS (LOWER COLUMN COVER REMOVAL/INSTALLATION).

**NOTE:** There is a screw for the column cover fixed behind the steering wheel and this screw cannot be removed without removing the steering wheel. Therefore, pay close attention to centering the wheel during removal and installation.

b. Remove the bolt (1) (2pcs.).



c. Move the wire harness cover (1) toward the yellow arrow, then loosen the set screw (2) 90 (+/- 10) degrees using a hexagonal wrench.

e. Install in the reverse order of removal.
