Symptom/Vehicle Issue: Turn Signal Lever Does Not Stay in The Desired Selected Position for

a Left or Right Turn

Customer Complaint/Technician Observation: Owner complains when the left or right turn is selected, the turn signal lever will not stay at the selected position; it returns to the neutral position. Technician observed the turn signal lever does turn on the turn signals as selected but the turn signal lever has no distinct detents and returns to the neutral position after a selection is made.

Discussion: The turn signal lever is designed to turn on the left or right turn signal as requested but return to the center neutral position after a selection is made. The monostable design does not have holding detent that would keep the lever in a selected position, it will always return to the neutral center position after the selection is made and turn off the signal after the turn has been completed.

Do not replace any parts for the above-described operation, all replacement parts will perform the same.

Note: If the turn signal direction is selected, reapplying the same directional selection will cancel the turn signal request without turning.
