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Symptom/Vehicle Issue: Wipers Inoperative After Motor Replacement

Technician Observation: Wiper motors during repair service and or replacement require a scan tool function to exit the wipers from an in-plant mode status, the wipers will not operate until this procedure is performed.

Discussion: If the wipers do not operate, after any motor replacement use the scan tool and select Vehicle Preparations > Wiper Status Setting > Wiper Exit Plant Mode.
