

Symptom/Vehicle Issue: Dome Lamp, Ultrasonic Antitilt Module (UAM), Alarm Siren Unit (ASU)

Inoperative After a Recent Module Flash

Technician Observation: Dome lamps do not turn on as expected, security warning lamp on, or Diagnostic Trouble Codes (DTC's) U1413-09, U1413-87 for UAM or U1412-09 for ASU.

Discussion: If the dome lamps do not operate after a recent service repair/module flash or the vehicle has the above DTCs. Use the scan tool to perform a Body Control Module (BCM) reset. Use the **wiTech select > Guided Diagnostics > Reset ECU > BCM.** Check the operation, if the dome lamps are still inoperative, perform a momentary battery disconnect and without delay reconnect the battery. No parts required, test the operation to complete.
