Symptom/Vehicle Issue: Automatic Head Lamp “ON” Feature Does Not Operate After a Recent Service Repair

Technician Observation: The nighttime auto headlamp “ON” feature is not working after a recent service repair that required a Restore Vehicle Configuration.

Discussion: Verify the vehicle has the combined rain/light sensor mounted on the windshield. For vehicles equipped with both systems, the vehicle configuration must have both the Auto Headlamp Feature (Set) and Rain Sensor Present (Set) for the auto headlamps to operate. Update or add any deleted sales codes to ensure both show (Set). Auto Headlamp Present sales code (LMG) and Rain Sensor Present (JHC) must be present before a **Vehicle Restore Configuration** Fig 1 and 2.

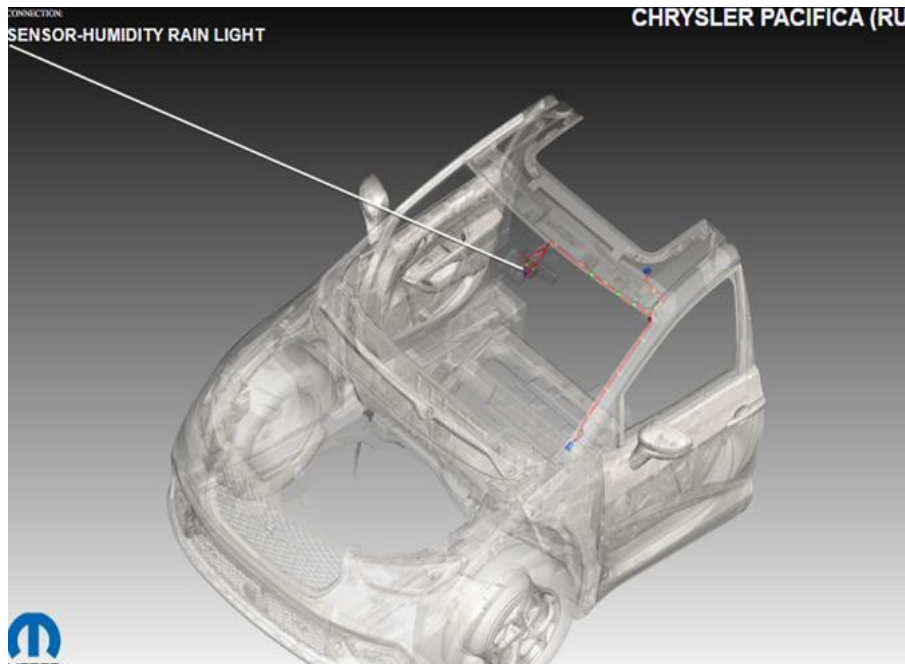
