Hardware-related deviation of the sensor mat ("hands on detection") in the steering wheel and software-related deviation in the steering wheel touch detection control module -*J1158*-.

or

- B17B8F2: control unit for steering wheel touch detection sensor fault
- Symptom: **8786912**

or

- U133E00: control unit for steering wheel touch detection, no communication
- Symptom: 197438

or

One of the following event entries must be logged in the front camera for driver assist systems (diagnosis address 00A5, sporadic/static):

- U112300: data bus, received error value
- Symptom: 1124393

or

- U112300: data bus, received error value
- Symptom: 1124477

Note:

When working on the airbag always observe the safety instructions in the repair manual.

Replace the steering wheel, enable operation of the control unit for multi-function steering wheel and the control unit for steering wheel touch detection.

Procedure:

- Remove the steering wheel according to the repair manual. See Repair Group 48 in Elsa.
- Install the new steering wheel according to the repair manual. See Repair Group 48 in Elsa.
- With Guided Fault Finding, enable the control unit for multi-function steering wheel and the control unit for steering wheel touch detection.
- Under "own test plan", select the diagnosis address "0019".
- In "test plan" operation mode, select the "LIN participants" function.
- In the "test plan" section, select and perform the "control unit for multi-function steering wheel start-up" function.
- In the "test plan" section, select and perform the "control unit for steering wheel touch detection startup" function.
