- 1. Access control module OBD for the 46 module and select **"Adaptation"**.
- Click the drop down arrow to the left of "Personalization of user account 1" (figure 1).
- Scroll down to "Rear lid release via rear lid open sensors".
- 4. Click the "**Input**" field and set it to "**Off**".
- 5. Repeat these steps for the personalization of user account(s) 1-7.

- While still in the "Adaptation" screen, click the drop down arrow to the left of "Personalization settings vehicle" (figure 2).
- Scroll down to "Rear lid release via rear lid open sensors".
- 8. Click the **"Input"** field and set it to **"Off"**.
- 9. Perform a 10 second key cycle and check the function of the virtual pedal.

To re-activate, follow the same steps listed above however change the "**Input**" setting to "**On**".
