Re: Warranty Extension: 2017-2019 Multi-Model 6AT Torque Converter

Today, August 31, 2023, American Honda is announcing a warranty extension for certain 2017 Accord, 2018 Odyssey, 2017-2018 Pilot and 2017-2019 Ridgeline vehicles. American Honda is extending the warranty on the torque converter to 8 years or 150,000 miles from the original date of purchase, whichever comes first.

BACKGROUND

Torque converters may not have been manufactured to proper specifications. As a result, the torque converter lock-up clutch cannot provide adequate holding force due to pressure bleeding down through a crack in the lock-up piston. The reduced lock-up clutch capacity results in the MIL illuminating and set DTC P0741 Torque Converter Clutch Circuit Performance or Stuck OFF.

REPAIR

Follow the diagnostic steps outlined in service bulletins 23-076, 23-077, and/or 23-078 to determine if the vehicle qualifies for this repair. For vehicles that qualify, replace the torque converter as outlined in the service bulletins.

PARTS

Part kits are available through the VIN control ordering process.

TOOLS

There are no special tools needed for this campaign.
