Re: Warranty Extension: 2017-2019 Multi-Model 6AT Torque Converter

On August 31, 2023, Acura is announcing a warranty extension for certain model year 2017-2018 RDX units.

Acura is extending the warranty on the torque converter to 8 years or 150,000 miles from the original date of purchase, whichever comes first.

**BACKGROUND**

Torque converters may not have been manufactured to proper specifications. As a result, the torque converter lock-up clutch cannot provide adequate holding force due to pressure bleeding down through a crack in the lock-up piston. The reduced lock-up clutch capacity results in the MIL illuminating and set DTC P0741 Torque Converter Clutch Circuit Performance or Stuck OFF.

**REPAIR**

Follow the diagnostic steps outlined in service bulletin 23-029 to determine if the vehicle qualifies for this repair. For vehicles that qualify, replace the torque converter as outlined in the service bulletin.

**PARTS**

Part kits are available through the VIN control ordering process.

**TOOLS**

There are no special tools needed for this campaign.

**SERVICE BULLETIN**

Service Bulletin 23-029, *Warranty Extension: 2017-18 RDX 6AT Torque Converter – DTC P0741 Stored* has posted to the Service Information System (SIS) as of August 31, 2023. It includes parts, repair, tools, and warranty information related to this warranty extension.

**CLIENT NOTIFICATION**

Acura expects to begin client notification by early October 2023.
