SITUATION

The interior lights in the rear of the passenger area do not work.

CAUSE

Unfavorable actuation of the interior light.

CORRECTION

Perform a 10-minute battery reset.

PROCEDURE

When a Model vehicle listed above arrives with the issue described in the Situation section, proceed first as follows:

- 1. Perform a 10-minute battery reset following the repair instructions listed in ISTA/AIR (61 20 900) and check the functionality of the interior lights.
- 2. If the interior light does not work after the battery reset, continue with your diagnosis.
