SERVICE ACTION: REPLACE CHASSIS GROUND CABLE NUT

THIS REPAIR IS MOBILE FRIENDLY

MODEL

G01 (X3 Sports Activity Vehicle) G02 (X4 Sports Activity Coupe)

SITUATION

An unapproved nut was used for the ground point for the chassis ground. Corrosion can occur on the ground nut over the life of the vehicle. As a result, malfunctions could occur, which are displayed in the vehicle by a check control message. In rare cases, local overheating at that ground point is a possibility.


CORRECTION

Replace the nut for the chassis grounds as applicable.

PROCEDURE

The ground point on the body of the vehicle is at different locations based on model type/options. Please refer to the vehicle type and the illustrations below.


Note: Vehicles with the 48V starter/generator and xDrive may require more than one ground nut replaced.



Vehicles with sDrive:

Remove the exhaust to access the transmission tunnel. Replace ground nut (1) at this location on the transmission tunnel.

Vehicles with xDrive:

Replace ground nut (1) at this location on the transfer case.



Vehicles with the 48V starter/generator: Replace ground nut (1) at this location on the body near the engine subframe.

PARTS INFORMATION

To determine the part number that applies to the specific vehicle being repaired, enter the VIN/chassis number into either ETK or AIR, this will consider the specific equipment and/or options that are fitted to the vehicle.

Small parts, such as screws, nuts, and seals, which must be replaced in accordance with ISTA repair instructions, must be selected from the Electronic Parts Catalog in accordance with the corresponding vehicle type and invoiced under the special defect code of this technical campaign.
