#### **DIAGNOSIS:**

If the customer describes any of the symptom listed above in the customer symptom section, perform the Repair Procedure.

NOTE: This Repair Procedure involves adding the foam pads to both visor mounting points, even if only one has the symptom/condition. Both sides must have the foam pad installed.

# **REPAIR PROCEDURE:**

1. Remove the sunvisor. Refer to the detailed service procedures available in DealerCONNECT/Service Library under: Service Info>23 - Body / Interior / Visor / Removal.

# NOTE: Do not apply foam pads to the visors.




Fig. 2 Foam Pad To The Sunvisor Body Mount Alignment Points

2. Peel and stick the foam pad to the sunvisor body mount (Fig. 1) . Ensure it is aligned horizontally with the front of the vehicle (Fig. 2) .



Fig. 1 Foam Pad To The Left Side Sunvisor Body Mount Location

- 1 Align Edge Of Foam To The Hole In Body LH/RH
- 2 Align Edge Of Foam To The Channel Form In The Body LH/RH
- 3 Horizontally Placed Foam Pad Left Side
- Install the sunvisor. Refer to the detailed service procedures available in DealerCONNECT/Service Library under: Service Info>23 - Body / Interior / Visor / Installation. Tighten fasteners to 2.5 N·m (22 in. lbs.).
