Symptom/Vehicle Issue: Oily Stain On Rear Seat Vinyl At The Seat Belt Buckle Locations.

Customer Complaint/Technician Observation: In hot climates (120 °F) with the rear seat folded an oily stain may appear on the seat trim.

Discussion: The appearance of an oily stain on the rear seat vinyl at the buckle sleeve locations is caused by a plasticizer which is part of the automotive vinyl manufacturing process. Leather and cloth materials are not affected as they do not have plasticizer. The oily stain can be cleaned from the seat and belt sleeve using either a mild dish soap or Mopar Total Clean 04897840GD/04318020AE with a microfiber towel. Follow the application directions on the product.
