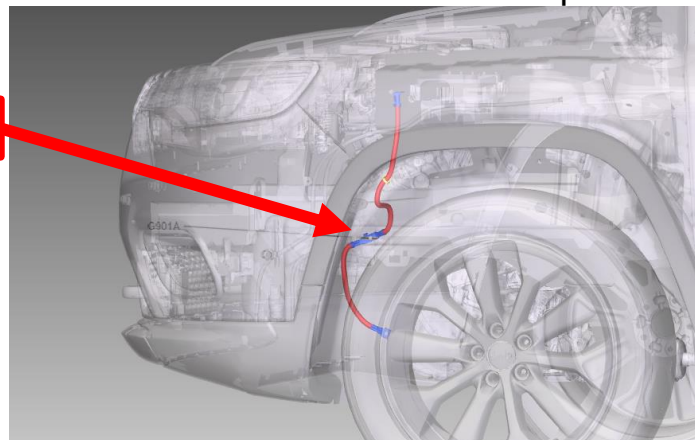
Symptom/Vehicle Issue: Intermittently The Vehicle exhibits No Crank No Start. Vehicle Goes Into Limp Home Mode. Multiple DTC's And Warning Lights

Discussion: The vehicle may experience an intermittent no crank, no start. You may also find that the vehicle goes into Limp Home mode while driving. When these situations occur multiple warning lights will be displayed in the cluster and numerous DTC's will set.

This may be caused by the main battery ground cable G901A being loose at the frame.

Diagnosis: Remove the drivers side wheel liner and inspect the G901A.

G901A Ground Stud



Repair: If the G901 attachment to the frame is loose, tighten the ground to 13 Ft. Lbs.
