

## **Mack Chassis - "Spitting" Or "puffing" Of Air From Purge Valve**

### **Description:**

Vehicles equipped with the Wabco System Saver (AIRM-W18) and Bendix AD-9 (AIRM-B11) air dryer systems with no turbo cut-off valve, may be reported to be "spitting" or "puffing" from the purge valve, as opposed to a steady and uninterrupted flow of air.

### **Conclusion:**

This is normal behavior in a system with the configuration of a single cylinder air compressor and an air dryer that does not have a turbo cut-off valve.

If the customer declines to accept the truck in this condition, a turbo cut-off valve can be installed.
