Symptom/Vehicle Issue: MIL On with TCM P1DB7 Active

Customer Complaint/Technician Observation: Customer may have a concern of a Check Engine or Malfunction Indicator Light on. The Technician will observe a P1DB7 DTC is setting as Active in the Transmission Control Module (TCM).

Discussion: If the Technician Observes the Customer Concern and Symptoms above, they should perform the following procedure:

- 1. Connect wiTECH to the Vehicle.
- 2. Save a Vehicle Scan Report.
- 3. Clear All DTCs.
- 4. Perform a test drive.
 - a. Drive vehicle at 40 to 50 MPH for 5 mins. This is best done with the cruise control engaged, while driving on a flat road. There needs to be as little throttle input as possible to get the diagnostics to run.
- 5. Did the TCM set P1DB7 again?

If Yes: Follow the published service diagnostics to determine the correct repair. **If No**: If the code does not reoccur a Permanent Solution is in development in engineering and will be available in a future service action.
